




ROOM N 1, FIRST FIND PLACE OF INSCRIBED TABLETS, NIYA SITE,






CHINESE AND TIBETAN SGRAFFITI ON WEST WALL OF HALL E III,


RELIEF SCULPTURES, R xiv-R Inv, ON OUTER SOUTH-EAST WALL, RAWAK STŪPA COURT

DANDĀN-UILIQ












ENDERÉ SITE




RUINED STŪPA, ENDERE SITE




FRAGMENTS OF GLAZED POTTERY FROM MOJI
